Château de Sibra is an estate in the south-western French department of Ariège, nestled in the foothills of the Pyrenees. Here, almost 150 years ago, the entrepreneur and romantic Joseph Villary de Fajac had the vision of combining the useful with the beautiful. Far away from everyday life and the confinement of its conventions, he created in Sibra a picturesque idyll of touching sensuality, unique quality, and a clear overriding sense of aesthetics.

After years of painstaking restoration of the buildings and the vast park, Château de Sibra has for the past two years once again been a place that

one can describe as a small paradise and discover anew again and again with its thousands of beautiful details. Since recently, Sibra is also available as a location for photo shoots and filming.







In addition, we offer a personal service on request and take care of the accommodation and catering for your entire team during the production.


We have 8 double rooms, 3 suites and three flats and up to 34 people can, therefore, stay directly on site.
